 Let him declare and lay out before me
what has happened since I established my ancient people,
 and what is yet to come—
 yes, let him foretell what will come.
⁸ Do not tremble, **do not be afraid**.
 Did I not proclaim this and foretell it long ago?
You are my witnesses. Is there any God besides me?
 No, there is no other Rock; I know not one."

²¹ **R**emember these things, O Jacob,
 for you are my servant, O Israel.
I have made you, you are my servant;
 O Israel, I will not forget you.
²² **I have swept away your offenses** like a cloud,
 your sins like the morning mist.
Return to me,
 for **I have redeemed you**."
²³ Sing for joy, O heavens, for the LORD has done this;
 shout aloud, O earth beneath.
Burst into song, you mountains,
 you forests and all your trees,
for **the LORD has redeemed Jacob**,
