Second Reading

1 Corinthians 15:51-57

Paul contrast the state of our perishable body with the imperishable body at the resurrection.

Look, I tell you a mystery. We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed, ⁵²in a moment, in the blink of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. ⁵³For this perishable body must put on imperishability, and this mortal body must put on immortality. ⁵⁴But once this perishable body has put on imperishability, and this mortal body has put on immortality, then what is written will be fulfilled:

Death is swallowed up in victory. ⁵⁵Death, where is your sting? Grave, where is your victory? ⁵⁶The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. ⁵⁷But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ!

Matthew 28:1-10

The women who grieved at Jesus' death were the first eyewitnesses of Jesus' victory over death.

After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb. ²Suddenly, there was a great earthquake! For an angel of the Lord came down from heaven, and going to the tomb, he rolled away the stone and was sitting on it. ³His appearance was like lightning, and his clothing was as white as snow. ⁴The guards were so terrified of him that they shook and became like dead men. ⁵The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid! I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. ⁶He is not here. He has risen, just as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay. ⁷Go quickly and tell his disciples, 'He has risen from the dead! And look, he is going ahead of you to Galilee. There you will see him.' See, I have told you!"

Sermon

1 Corinthians 15:51-57

Christ is Risen! There's Going to Be a New Normal.

Apostles' Creed

In a world that has difficulty believing in the one true God, but is so ready to believe that our universe happened by some unknown accident, what do you believe? I believe in God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth.
