First Lesson Jeremiah 9:1-9

The unbelieving world will slander and speak against all who seek to serve the Lord.

Now I wish my head were a spring of water and my eyes a fountain of tears. Then I would weep day and night for the fallen of my people. ²I wish there was a lodging place for travelers in the wilderness. Then I would leave my people and get away from them. They are all adulterers, a society of traitors. ³They bend their tongues like bows, to deceive. It is not by faithfulness that they prevail in the land. They go from evil to evil, and they do not acknowledge me, declares the LORD.

⁴Everyone should be on guard against his friend. Do not trust any brother, for every brother is really a deceiver, and every friend spreads slander. ⁵Everyone betrays his friend, and no one speaks the truth. They have taught their tongues to lie. They wear themselves out with sinning.

⁶You, Jeremiah, live in the midst of deception! In their deceit they refuse to acknowledge me, declares the LORD. ⁷Therefore this is what the LORD of Armies says. Watch me. I will refine them and test them. What else can I do for my dear people? ⁸Their tongues are like deadly arrows. They speak deceitfully. With their mouths they speak peacefully to their neighbors, but in their hearts they set traps.

⁹Shall I not punish them for these things? declares the LORD. Shall I not avenge myself on such a nation as this?

Second Lesson

1 Peter 4:1-8

Believers cause great surprise through their sanctified life.

Therefore, because Christ suffered in flesh, arm yourselves with the same mindset, because the one who has suffered in flesh is done with sin. ²Do this so that you no longer live the rest of your time in the flesh for human desires but for God's will. ³Indeed, you have already spent enough time in the past doing what the Gentiles want to do: living in unbridled immorality, lusts, drunkenness, orgies, drinking parties, and disgusting idolatry.

⁴For this reason, they are surprised that you do not plunge into the same overflowing river of filth with them, and they slander you. ⁵They will have to give an account to the one who is ready to judge the living and the dead. ⁶In fact, it was for this reason that the gospel was preached also to those who are dead, so that they might be judged the way people are judged in flesh and that they might live the way God lives in spirit.

⁷The end of all things is near. So have sound judgment and be self-controlled for the sake of your prayers. ⁸Above all, love each other constantly, because love covers a multitude of sins.

⁵²He said to them, "Therefore every expert in the law who has been trained as a disciple in the kingdom of heaven is like the owner of a house who brings out of his treasure both new things and old things."


What Is the World to Me Christian Worship 477
