

### First Lesson Isaiah 49:1-6

### Second Lesson Acts 16:25-34

The gospel spreads to all in Word and Sacrament

About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. <sup>26</sup>Suddenly there was such a violent earthquake that the foundations of the prison were shaken. Instantly all the doors were opened, and everyone's chains came loose. <sup>27</sup>When the jailer woke up and saw that the prison doors were opened, he drew his sword and was about to kill himself, because he thought that the prisoners had escaped. <sup>28</sup>But Paul shouted with a loud voice, "Don't harm yourself, because we are all here!"

<sup>29</sup>The jailer called for lights, rushed in, and fell down trembling in front of Paul and Silas. <sup>30</sup>Then he brought them outside and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"

<sup>31</sup>They said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, you and your household." <sup>32</sup>They spoke the word of the Lord to him and to everyone in his home. <sup>33</sup>At the same hour of the night, he took them and washed their wounds. Without delay, he and all his family were baptized. <sup>34</sup>Then he brought Paul and Silas into his house and set food before them. He rejoiced, because he and his whole household had come to believe in God.

## Gospel

#### Mark 1:4-11

The Father declared Jesus his Son and the Spirit anointed him as Messiah.

John appeared, baptizing in the wilderness and preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. <sup>5</sup>The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem were going out to him. They were baptized by him in the Jordan River as they confessed their sins. <sup>6</sup>John was clothed in camel's hair, and he wore a leather belt around his waist. He ate locusts and wild honey. <sup>7</sup>He preached, "One more powerful than I is coming after me. I am not worthy to stoop down and untie the strap of his sandals! <sup>8</sup>I baptized you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

<sup>9</sup>In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. <sup>10</sup>Just as Jesus came up out of the water, he saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. <sup>11</sup>And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love. ### Confession of Faith Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one being with the Father. Through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation, he came down from heaven, was incarnate of the Holy Spirit and the virgin Mary, and became fully human. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate. He suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who in unity with the Father and the Son is worshiped and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy

Christian\* and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

\*The original word here in Greek from the church council in Nicea in 325 is often translated "Catholic." It refers to the universal church, not just the Roman Catholic church. We join with all believers everywhere of all time in confessing these truths.
