## DISCUSS: PART 4 - COMBATING ERRORS TODAY

- 1. The Formula of Concord and Augsburg Confession both appeal to the Nicene Creed. They clearly stated that they followed Scripture alone as the sole authoritative source of spiritual truth. What reasons might they have had for mentioning the Creed?
- 2. Identify in which contexts the Nicene Creed can still be most useful today. In which context may it not serve as well for us to cite the Nicene Creed?
- **3.** Why must we be careful not to appeal to the age or widespread appeal of a creed when trying to bolster its usefulness?
- 4. Agree / Disagree "A creed is only useful if it can summarize Scripture and build consensus for wide-spread usage."
- 5. Explain how the Nicene Creed offers a practical tool... for worship...for evangelism.
